- Mrs Johnson (coming in) : Hello !
- Mr Johnson (in the kitchen) : Hello, **darling** ! I'm **in the kitchen**.
- Mrs Johnson : What are you doing, **dear** !
- Mr Johnson : I'm drinking a tea.
- Mrs Johnson : What is Jenny doing ?
- Mr Johnson : **She's in her bedroom**. She's working.
- Mrs Johnson : And John ?
- Mr Johnson : **He's outside**, **in the garden**. He's playing basketball **with his friends**.
